COBIS - The Digital Workbook & LMS

As a Supporting Member we were delighted to have the opportunity to work directly with COBIS recently on a new project to develop two key online services:

- A learning management system to deliver COBIS Learning Programmes including CPML and CPSL
- A compliance and accreditation platform for member schools the "Digital Workbook"



Working closely with the COBIS team, led by Peter Simpson and Sakina Zafar, we designed a custom Moodle solution which would incorporate and integrate the two key elements, alongside an implementation plan to ensure the COBIS team would be guided at each stage of the process, and properly supported post-launch.

Key considerations in ensuring the new platform was a success included:

- Single Moodle system integrating both services
- Ompatible with mobile, tablet and desktop devices
- Elastic hosting for scalability and performance
- Bespoke theme design to maximise usability



The new platform was designed from a user-centric perspective, with a clean and clear interface. We developed a fully responsive theme to guarantee usability across a range of devices, and followed COBIS brand guidelines to ensure a consistent appearance with the organisation's existing web properties.

With the project now in the initial rollout stage, we look forward to feedback from COBIS members.
